Using Zoom, the organizing committee will host the paper presentations, keynotes, fast-forward of posters and demos, and announcements (e.g., awards). There will be different links for the session to aid recording purposes. There will be a unique link for:

The zoom links will be available on the discord server under #zoomlinks. Note that the session chairs and general chairs will be taking questions during each of the presentations. Those questions will be read from the Zoom chat pane. However, we encourage you to continue the conversation with authors and keynote speakers via discord.

The posters will have available videos and live (if possible, depending on availability of poster presenters) during the Posters/Demo sessions (Day 1 and Day 2). We will also host a social in discord for 60 minutes to talk about anything and have fun. Also, use discord as much as you want, as people will use it as conversations.
